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
### Problem Statement: Missed Opportunities for Sharing Digital Resources within AUN

#### **Current challenges**

- No commonly used method for AUN+3 instructors to:
- scan, select, and use digital resources developed at other AUN+3 members
- 2) review and endorse available digital resources
- 3) <u>share</u> self-developed digital resources with other AUN+3 instructors

# "How can I encourage the use and the sharing of resources on the MERLOT platform?"

- Making clear the ground rules and best practices can help to encourage the use and sharing on MERLOT

Taking into account faculty members' contributions to the Scholarship of Teaching and Learning through teaching awards





### Why MERLOT?

#### MERLOT as an Exchange Platform

- Widely known and reputable (established since 1997)
- Critical mass of digital resources available already
- Accommodates a wide variety of resources in different technical formats



### **URL:** merlot.org

- Incorporates user reviews, ratings, and other endorsement mechanisms
- Aligned with the <u>Creative Commons License</u> framework, a commonly accepted Intellectual Property regimes
- Integration with various Learning Management Systems (LMS)
- Allows sharing resources in different languages
- Strong alignment to AUN-TEPL goals and a willingness and ability to work with AUN-TEPL as a MERLOT Community Partner to meet AUN-TEPL's needs (e.g. support for professional development activities and access to a data analytics dashboard for reporting)




### Benefits of joining a resource-sharing community

- Enhance academic reputation by being a Peer Reviewer or one of the Editorial boards



### **Roles of MERLOT Users**

#### **Contributor - Share:**

- Contribute digital resources for AUN+3 community and beyond
- Maintain and improve resource development and sharing standards

#### Adopter - Scan, Select, and Use:


- Perform personalised searches e.g. by subject discipline, keywords, etc.
- Choose curated and peer reviewed digital resources
- Use and/or adapt resources

#### **Reviewer - Review and Endorse:**

- Provide ratings and reviews based on use in courses

### **User's Story - Associate Professor Seow Poh Sun**

The Associate Editor of Accounting in MERLOT had done an Editor Review that she has looked at Professor Seow's submitted resource and believes it is a **high-quality material and is deserving of a Peer Review**. This is the first stage of the MERLOT Peer Review Process. Professor Seow's app joins others that have been identified during this stage.

The Associate Editor at some point will assign two of our Peer Reviewers to review the resource independently and then will review it herself and provide the Consolidated Peer Review, which will then be sent to the Author for approval before it is posted on MERLOT.




